



If your club members are having a poor dance experience because they have trouble hearing the music or the callers/cuers, the Hear-2-DanceSM system might provide the solution you are looking for.

You can provide your dancers a low cost Hear-2-Dance system in **3 easy steps**.

Step 1. Have your club purchase an off-the-shelf FM transmitter meeting the Hear-2-Dance requirements (as shown on www.hear-2-dance.com). The cost should be less than \$70.

Step 2. Have those dancers who need hearing assistance purchase walkman type FM radios meeting the Hear-2-Dance requirements. A Sony model is available at Wal-Mart, Target, Sears, and the Sony website for \$30. (When not used for dancing these radios can be used for listening to regular FM stations, AM stations, and TV channels). Note: the Sony radio comes with earphones. If dancers wish to use ear buds, or ear links instead, these can be easily purchased for about \$10.

Step 3. Connect the transmitter to your caller/cuer's amplifier at each dance and provide a sign letting dancers know the Hear-2-Dance system is in use and on what frequency they should set their FM radios. (Instructions for connecting the transmitter is provided at www.hear-2-dance.com)
